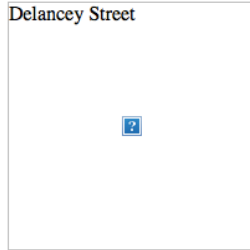


# Rachael Sage - Delancey Street

New York singer-songwriter Rachael Sage has been prolific in her career so far. Having released eight studio albums so far (soon to be nine), Sage is also the president of her own record label MPress Records. Known for her quirky personality, lyrically honest songs and incredible musical skills, Sage is about to release her ninth studio album **Delancey Street**.

**Delancey Street** is a collection of 13 songs (11 originals and 2 covers) that are easily relatable and straight from the heart. Opening with the heartbreaking **Hope's Outpost** where Sage sings of a lover that leaves her for someone else, the album kicks off with an emotional punch that you can't help but be moved by. Emotion runs throughout the rest of the record as Sage explores different aspects of life and relationships.

Over the course of the record Sage takes a tongue-in-cheek look at the pressures of celebrity on the punchy **Big Star**, pays tribute to an absent sister on **Everything Was Red** and yearns to be in the company of a love separated by miles on **Meet Me In Vegas**. The album's two covers (**Rich Girl** and **Fame**) fit neatly into the tracklisting with the latter being particularly effective as a stripped-down piano ballad.

The album's strongest moment comes on the piano-ballad **Back To Earth**. Sage sings to a friend that is falling apart in front of her eyes leaving her feeling helpless. Her voice captures the devastation of standing by with no idea what to do when a friend you hold dear is spiralling into the depths of despair. Dare we say the song even made us shed a tear?

**Delancey Street** is an album crafted with love, passion and honesty. Rachael Sage may not be a household name but she's an artist that deserves an audience. Nine albums in and she's showing no signs of slowing down. **Delancey Street** is every bit affecting and enjoyable as any other record Sage has recorded. If you're a fan of female singer-songwriters then you simply have to get yourself a copy of this record.
